

I Needed Counseling to Move Forward

My name is Kelly*. I came to lowa broken, from so very many things. After my husband died, I started dating a nice guy who unexpectedly also passed away. I was so heartbroken and overwhelmed by grief and loneliness. I ended up losing my job. With no income, I could not afford my house.

In an effort to start over and escape my sadness, I moved back home to lowa. Being a middle age woman, it is embarrassing to need to move in with your parents. My parents immediately helped me connect with Children & Families of Iowa (CFI). I needed counseling so that I could move forward.

My depression had some very dark moments. I held a lot of anger and that came out in unhealthy behavior.

The anger and grief caused my son and I to become estranged. I feared I had lost yet another one of the most important people in my life. Through therapy at CFI, I was able to find new ways of communicating with him and taking accountability for my actions. He's now back in my life and with work our relationship is continuing to mend.

My therapist recommended Eye Movement Desensitization and Reprocessing (EMDR) therapy to help me heal from the traumas in my life. EMDR was a very successful path for my recovery.

Now I have a much better life, and all those issues are far behind me. Before the treatment, I was afraid to try anything new. I have self-confidence now. I'm taking college courses and I met someone special. I now have healthy tools to help me bounce back from life's challenges. Now I have a whole new outlook on life.
