


# Mental Health in Youth Impacts Life Choices

Kaylee had been plagued with mental health issues since the death of her parents, which occurred when she was very young. "At 34, I still struggle with the aftermath of addiction and domestic violence," states Kaylee\*. "I started services with Children & Families of Iowa (CFI) in an effort to regain custody of my son. He tested positive for methamphetamine at the time of his birth. I felt so ashamed that I had trouble acknowledging my husband's violence toward me and the severity of our substance usage.

With no support system, Kaylee relapsed. After appearing in Family Court, I realized that if I were going to regain custody of my son, I needed more help. I connected with CFI's Substance Abuse Services," says Kaylee. Through two types of therapy, she continued to build her recovery, developing healthy coping skills, and learning about how her son was affected by the family's domestic violence and substance use. "I have become more confident and independent, rebuilding relationships with my sisters, and finding full-time employment."

Through all of her hard work, Kaylee has regained custody of her son and ended the abusive relationship with her ex-husband. She has maintained her full-time employment and continues to advance in her career. She is in the process of terminating her ex-husband's parental rights due to his ongoing struggles with addiction.

"With everything I've been through, I am so happy to have CFI's services." She is now able to provide her son a childhood she was never able to have.
